

## Admissions Procedures



Parents/Guardians who contact the school for information will be invited to attend a one-to-one conference at which time a tour of the school will be conducted. The school administrator will be available to answer questions and assist with the application process.

All Kindergarten children must be 5 years of age by December 2<sup>nd</sup> of the year of admittance.

Admissions are determined by the number of openings available in each grade. Evaluation of current Progress Reports (Report Cards) and Conduct Evaluation determine admissions priorities for transfer students.

## About our school

Hope Lutheran Elementary School is dedicated to the philosophy of providing an excellent Christian education for children.

Hope Lutheran Church founded a Pre-School after recognizing a need in the community for quality Christian education and childcare. Following a positive response to its Pre-School, the Kindergarten class was opened in 1998 and each succeeding year a new grade will be added until all the elementary grades have been established. Currently, Hope Lutheran Elementary School offers education for children in Kindergarten – Sixth grade. To facilitate the formation of this new elementary school, Hope Lutheran is working cooperatively with the Administration and Faculty of West Portal Lutheran School which has operated a successful elementary and middle school since 1951.

Our school seeks close cooperation of home, school and church with the goal of guiding young people to fulfill their purpose in life as educated, dedicated Christian citizens.

Elementary School hours are 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.



## The Curriculum

The curriculum includes those subjects commonly taught in elementary schools as set forth by the State of California. A strong emphasis is placed on basic traditional academic subjects.

Report cards are issued four times a year, and Parent Teacher Conferences are held twice a year. The Stanford Achievement Test will be given annually to all students in grade 1 and above.

As a Christian Day School, the Christian faith and the Bible are taught in the classroom. Students will attend a weekly Chapel Service on Wednesday mornings.

## Sat Scores

Each year our students from grade 1 and above participate in the Stanford Achievement Test in order to assess the academic progress of each student. With the results of the test we are able to enhance the strengths and address the weaknesses of each student. Our students have scored above grade level on the national average for the past five years.

## Uniforms & Lunches

Students are expected to wear a uniform. Parents will be provided price and purchase information. Children are expected to bring their lunches daily or purchase their lunches through the school lunch program.

## Faculty & Staff

Our faculty members are highly qualified. They are credentialed teachers in California and certified by our Lutheran Educational System of higher learning. Each teacher is a dedicated servant in Christ who loves the Lord and His children.

## Parent Involvement

All parents are members of the Parent-Teacher League which assists with field trips, class parties, seminars, fundraising and evening programs.



## Before & After School Care

Hope Lutheran Elementary School offers early morning supervision, beginning at 7:00 a.m., and after school supervision until 6:00 p.m. After School Enrichment classes are also available.
